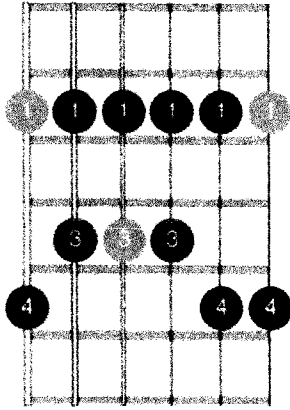

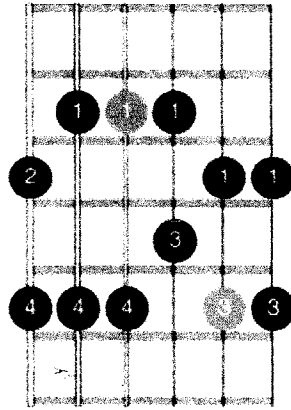
PS Are these the 5 positions of basic pentatonic scales you mean, Reg?

Pattern 1



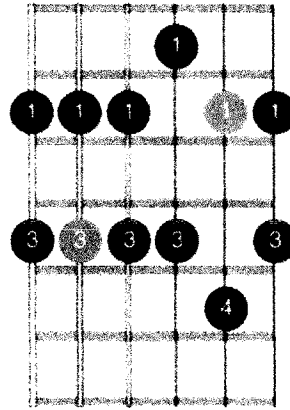

Pattern 2



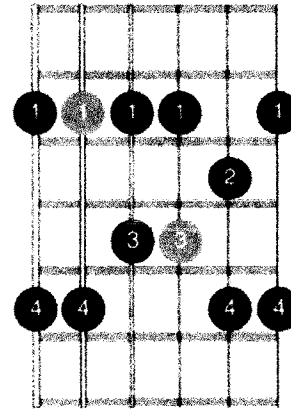

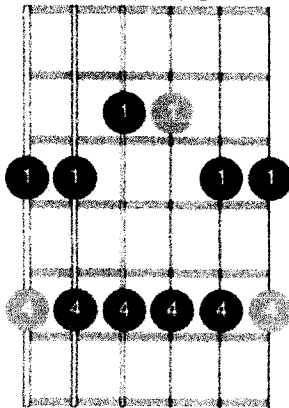
